Important information regarding GCSE grades for Year 11.

The government has announced how GCSE grades for Summer 2020 will be determined. Teachers will be asked to predict the grades we think pupils would have achieved in the summer exams, using evidence such as mock examinations (PPEs) and other assessments such as course work and controlled assessments. Exam boards will combine this with other data, such as pupil's prior attainment (Key Stage 2 results) to produce a calculated grade.

Exam boards aim to provide these calculated grades to pupils, which will be viewed in the same way as any other GCSE grades, by the end of July. If pupils and parents are unhappy with this grade, pupils have the option to sit an examination early in the new academic year or Summer 2021.
