Dear Pupils and parents

We look forward to welcoming pupils to school on Thursday 20th August to collect their GCSE results.

I just wanted to give a few health and safety reminders prior to the day. Please take the time to read this advice as it is for the safety of pupils and staff.

Results Day Arrangements

- Pupils should follow Coronavirus (COVID-19): safer travel guidance for passengers when planning the journey to school, and where possible, walk or cycle.
- Each pupil has been given an appointment time to collect their results. Pupils must arrive unaccompanied at their given time. Although we know many parents will want to be part of the results day experience, this is simply to reduce the number of people in the school building at any one time. **Please note, pupils who arrive early will be asked to return at their appointment time. Pupils who arrive late will be asked to return at 12.00 p.m. to collect their results.**
- When pupils arrive at school, they will be directed into school via one of 2 entrances, again to minimise larger groups of pupils. They will be asked to line up and then they will be invited one at a time to collect their results.
- Once on school premises, pupils must ensure that they adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- Please remember that pupils cannot mix in groups once they have collected their results, either in or out of school and, once they have collected their results, they should make their way home.
- **Please note if you or any member of your household have coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, pupils must not attend school on results day. We will send results to pupils securely.**
