## Identifying and supporting young carers at St Matthew's RC High School.

At St. Matthew's we are aware that some of our pupils are young carers. A young carer is someone under 18 who is caring unpaid for a family member or friend who is ill, frail, disabled, suffers from mental health or addiction. They often take on practical and/or emotional caring responsibilities that would normally be expected of an adult.

Research suggests there are at least 700,000 young carers in the UK but many do not realise they are a young carer.

We know that young carers may need extra support to both enjoy and make good progress at school. At St. Matthew's we are committed in our responsibility to ensure that all pupils who are young carers are identified and supported effectively.

If you think your child might be a young carer, or could be affected by any of the issues we've highlighted, please let me know by completing the form below and returning in a sealed envelope addressed to myself.
