Retrieval, this is when you are set tasks that require you to recall knowledge previously learnt.

Repetition, this is when you practice specific tasks and activities, requiring you to apply your knowledge and understanding.

Reading, these tasks promote the importance of reading across all subject areas. It exposes you to subject specific vocabulary in a variety of contexts.



Revision, this additional R will appear where your class teachers are using specific revision strategies to support your preparation for an assessment or exam.
