Welcome.

Thank you for taking the time to consider applying for the post of Foundation governor.

The core business of St Matthew's is teaching, learning and achievement. Our core purpose is our Catholic ethos. - To oversee the financial performance of the school making sure that money is well spent.

In order to strengthen the collective skills of the current governors, we are looking for an individual who has an expertise in business and finance. This would include contributing to the strategic discussions at governing board meetings (approx. 6 per year) which determine the school's budget, and further supporting the governing body in demonstrating that it is aware of the financial situation and is trying to manage it. Previous school governor experience is not essential and we would be able to offer further training as necessary. Ideally, this governor will have an experienced financial background and be able to ask challenging questions of school leaders.
